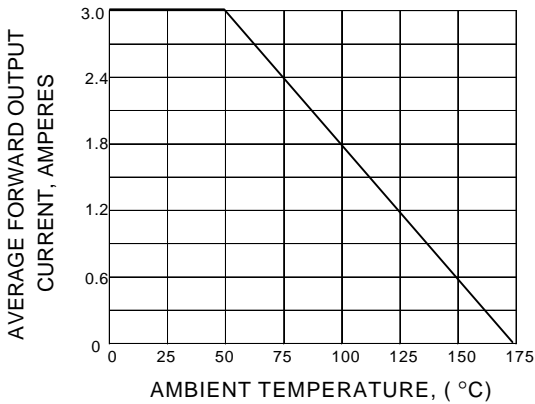

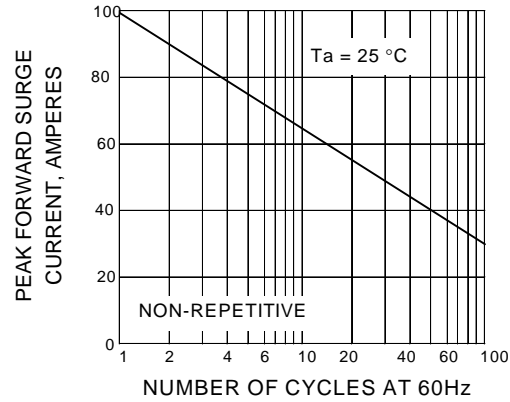

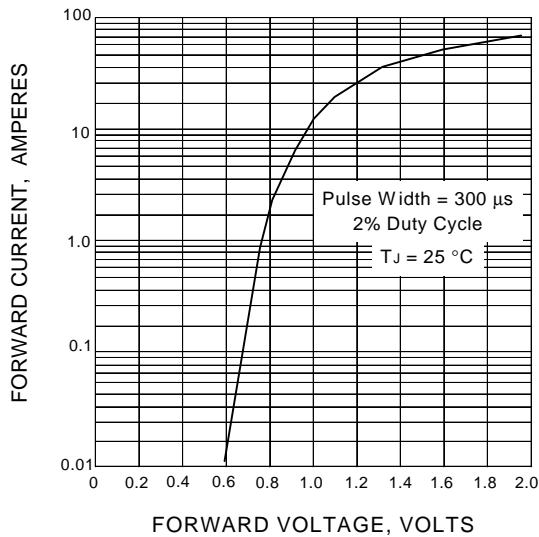
**FIG.1 - DERATING CURVE FOR OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT**



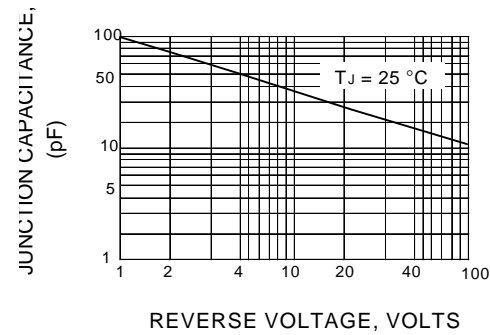
**FIG.2 - MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT**
