




14. Transfer characteristics waveforms










- (1) Positive-going edge.

- (2) Negative-going edge.


Fig 13. Average additional supply current as a function of V_{CC} for 74HCT14; linear change of V_I between 0.1 V_{CC} to 0.9 V_{CC} .


Fig 14. Relaxation oscillator


Fig 16. Package outline SOT27-1 (DIP14)


Fig 17. Package outline SOT108-1 (SO14)


Fig 18. Package outline SOT337-1 (SSOP14)




Fig 20. Package outline SOT762-1 (DHVQFN14)
